This film shows why our country is in a food crisis. "50 Million Americans - 1 in 4 children - don't know where their next meal is coming from". Based on the WCSD 2013 PA Youth Survey (PAYS), 16.1% of our 6th graders worry that the food at home is going to run out before the family has money to buy more. (State rate is 9.1%) Overall, 14.2% of our youth in grades 6, 8, 10, and 12 worry about the same. (State rate is 9.5%). 8.5% of our 12th graders said that they have skipped a meal due to family not having enough money to buy food. (State rate is 5.8%). **HUNGER IS REAL HERE**
